

Press Release: February 13th, 2018

On February 6, 2018, at approximately 1012 hours, Jake Henderson, 30, of 15 Shaw Street Apt. #A, Sanford, Maine, was summonsed for Operating While License Suspended or Revoked following a traffic stop on Sanford Road. Jake is scheduled to appear at York District Court on April 17, 2018, at 0815 hours.
