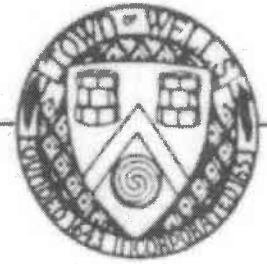

**Press Release: February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018**
