



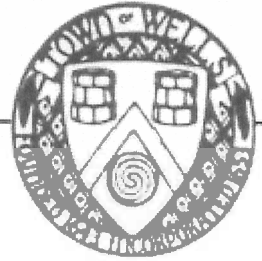

Press Release: March 27th, 2018

On March 20, 2018, at approximately 1502 hours, Ian Perry, 42, of 52 Moose Bog Lane, Wells, Maine, was arrested after an incident at the Wells Elementary School for Refusing to Submit to Arrest or Detention.
