Re: Ordinance Change Proposal – Exempt Farm Stands and Lemonade Stands

<u>Proposal</u>: Exempt Farm Stands and Lemonade Stands from requiring site plan approval or Home Business permits.

Reasons:

Homeowner operated farm stands and lemonade type stands operated by minors would currently require site plan or a Home Business permit approval. The following ordinance changes are proposed to exempt such minor/incidental uses from Town permitting; similar to the existing exemptions for a School Bus Shelter and Public Transportation Shelter.

Proposed Ordinance Changes:

§145-10. Definitions.

FARM STAND (NON-COMMERCIAL)

A free standing structure not more than 100 square feet in footprint area and not more than 10 feet in building height used for the sale of agricultural or livestock/poultry products grown or raised on the property where the structure is located.

FOOD STAND (NON-COMMERCIAL)

A free standing structure not more than 50 square feet in footprint area and not more than 10 feet in building height used by a minor person (under the age of 16) for the sale of items such as lemonade, cookies, etc.

§145-47.3. Non-Commercial Farm Stands and Food Stands

- A single Farm Stand (non-commercial) which is accessory to an existing residential use, may be placed within required right of way setbacks as set forth in Article V and is not subject to the requirements of Article X or §145-51.
- B. A Food Stand (non-commercial) may be placed within required right of way setbacks as set forth in Article V and is not subject to the requirements of Article X or §145-51.
